Format of Weekend

Saturday & Sunday – Graded driven dressage qualifier. Note, subject to the number of entries, the organising committee reserves the right to run the 2 qualifiers on Saturday (i.e. one in the morning and one in the afternoon).

Sunday – Cones practice. Practice your cones driving through a championship level cones course. Depending on the number of participants, you may be able to drive the cones course more than once.

Sunday - Practice in the MO's (4 will be lettered). A loop of approximately 700m will be set up and on each loop you can drive 1 MO.

Junior Persons (drivers/grooms/others) on Carriages

Any person on a carriage who is under 18 years of age must wear protective headgear in accordance with ACDS by-laws.

Awards

This is a training weekend. There will be no awards.

Camping

There are no powered sites. Please make your own arrangements. Generators are to be turned off at 9.30pm and only generators with a quiet motor are allowable. Showers and toilets in separate area will be available.

Dogs

Dogs are allowed but must be kept on a leash at all times. You are required to clean up after your dogs at all times.

No Fires

No fires are allowed on the reserve at any time.

Rubbish

Rubbish bins will be available for rubbish.

Local Shops

Greenvale Shopping Centre is a 5-minute drive.

Helmets

Helmets must be worn for cones and marathon practice (Sunday) and must comply with the ACDS by-law on helmets. If helmets are worn in other parts of the competition, they must comply with the ACDS by-law on helmets.

Medical Information Holders

Properly completed medical information holders are compulsory for both drivers and grooms in Victoria and are to be worn and must be clearly visible at all times when on a carriage during the event.
